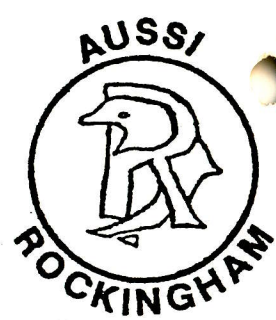

NEWS from the last Council of Clubs Meeting

The new AUSSI office is now operating from the Superdrome at Mt. Claremont. Office hours will be Tue, Wed, & Thrs from 9.30 am until 3.30 pm

Our Administrator and Vice President have both resigned, and AUSSI urgently needs replacement - even on a part time basis. Remember - Administrator is now a paid job.

Anyone going to the world swim in Brisbane, will be required to do appx two hours of time-keeping.

Financial membership 1988 goes only to 30th SEPTEMBER. From there on, the financial year will start 1st October. This brings us in line with the Top Ten and Aerobic closing dates. Also new for 1988 is that proof of age will be required from new members.

The new INTERCLUB SWIM MEET programme is on a 12 month trial. For February - Rockingham will swim in Inglewood, June in Carine, September we have our own carnival again in Mandurah, and November will see us for the first time in Somerset. The changes are as follows:  
Competitors may swim only THREE individual events at each interclub meet. If a club member misses their own interclub swim, they are ineligible to swim for points in other meets hosted that month. Relay entries are limited to 1 team per age group in each relay event. 25m Novice events will score 1 point only.

AGGREGATE AGE GROUP MEDALS will be awarded at the completion of the year to the culminative winners male, and female in each age group. Host clubs will charge \$ 1 on top of pool entry to cover the cost of the medals and administration. There will also be an INTERCLUB SWIM MEET HANDICAP TROPHY to the overall winning club of the season, using a handicap formular.
